Application for Transfer Credit



Centenary University will grant credit for courses taken in the Winter and Summer sessions at another institution as transfer credit only if the following criteria are met and with advisor approval:

- 1. Centenary University will accept the transfer credit if the grade is C- or better. Pass (P) credit courses are not transferable.
- 2. Attendance at the other college was approved by the Centenary University Administration prior to the start of the class.
- 3. Credit will not be granted until an official transcript has been received by the Centenary University Registrar's Office.
- 4. Students from community (junior) college's and/or proprietary schools are allowed a maximum of 66 semester credit hours which may be transferable to any Centenary baccalaureate degree program, to the extent that they are applicable to a particular program. A maximum of 90 credits from a four-year institution or combination of two and four-year institutions may be transferred.
- 5. A maximum of 50% of the courses (credits) of a specified major program may be transferred toward the requirements of that major. Courses in excess of that percentage may be counted toward the elective portion of the degree program. Exceptions will be made for institutions with which Centenary has completed a formal articulation agreement.
